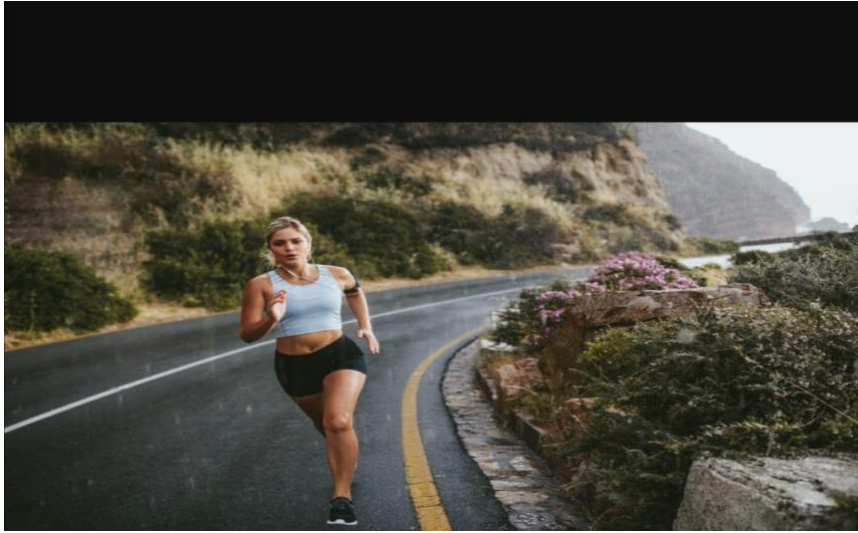


ADAM WAS PUT INTO A DEEP SLEEP



In the early hours of the 25th of August 2020, I had a dream of a girlfriend and I \ walking on the beach, talking about the deep things of God. We unknowingly ended up inside a small beige colored tent. As we sat on the floor cross- legged, deep in conversation, we heard something outside. I leaned over to unzip the dome shape tent door, and we peered outside. There were two men outside of the tent, not too far away. One of the men was laying on the ground facing up. All I could see was his naked chest, neck to waist. The vision highlighted his ribcage area. The second man, who I discerned as my Pastor (*spiritual father*), was standing in between the tent and the man laying there. He was looking down at the man as if praying or speaking over him. My Pastor also had no shirt on, and was wearing green underpants... it reminded me of superman underwear for the Garden of Eden! I also discerned that the color of the green was that of a signal light, giving us the ‘green light’ to go and move. As my girlfriend and I looked out, we discussed whether we should go out or stay inside. We were both a little fearful to step out, but we knew we couldn’t stay in there forever (*like Peter stepping out of the boat*). My friend climbed out first and left. I stayed behind wondering what I should do. My Pastor turned around and walked over to the tent door. He leaned in and asked what I was doing? I told him I was nervous and too shy to come out because the man lying there was half naked, with his chest exposed. I was fearful that he had no clothes on at all because I couldn’t see more than his defined chest and stomach. My Pastor stretched forth his hand and told me not be afraid. I took his hand and I climbed out of the tent... (*Genesis 2:20-22*) *But for Adam no suitable helper was found. 21 So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep, and while he slept, He took one of the man’s ribs and closed up the area with flesh. 22 And from the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man, He made a woman and brought her to him...*



The dream continued and suddenly I was jogging. The geographical area reminded me of my parents home and street. I left their house and headed toward the mountain to the East. (*Ezekial 47*) There was an orange orchard to my right and a grape vineyard on my left. The air was so fresh, crisp and clean (*4th dimension*). There were huge puddles of water on the sides of the road, everywhere (*Isaiah 41:18*). It must have just rained overnight (*Former and Latter Rain*). The brightness of sun shone so bright that it almost blinded my eyes and I had to squint (*Matt 17:1-6*). As I continued running, I approached a woman at a standstill in the street. I was a few feet away as she starts to wet herself through her clothes (*Mark 10:29-31*). I thought that was odd and I felt bad and embarrassed for her. The expression on her face was quite surprised and shocked at what was happening. She politely greeted me “Hello”, as jogged past her and also said “Hello.” I realize at this moment it was my aunt! I no sooner pass her as I see my husband’s car drive past me on the street. I thought, “Wait, was he coming to look for me? Or was it someone who has a similar car? (I remembered seeing him previously on a mountain road. I was driving up the hill as he was walking down, set apart from the rest of the crowd where he was highlighted to me. But this time, I was jogging up toward the hill and he was driving down). As I approached the base of the mountain before I ascend, I saw people starting to emerge from the vineyard to my left. Some people started walking toward me, while others stood in warmth of the sun, as if still waking up.



Next I remember sitting in a room, as if at a meeting. There were people sitting at brown wooden tables, paired in 2's (Luke 10). I discerned someone sitting next to me but don't recall seeing who it was. Everyone was facing me. I thought, "Wait a minute, AM I SUPPOSED TO BE TALKING ABOUT SOMETHING? Why is everyone looking ME?" I

start to speak on how we were 'on schedule' to have a great year with harvest. I explained how my dad in the past had to deal with problems in the vineyard, but we didn't have to worry about any of that. Even with everything going on around us, the crop was perfect and it was going to be abundant! (*Luke 10:1-12*).

We have come out of a long season of being in the wilderness and the Lord has been making room for divine alignments and connections. He is establishing new friendships as well as kingdom marriages. Adam had been busy building and working in Eden, when the Lord decided it was no longer good for Adam to be alone. Before God could bring Eve out and place her before Adam, God caused a deep sleep to fall on him. In my dream, as Adam lay there sleeping, I was afraid to step out. After an intense season of witchcraft and warfare, we have been left feeling doubtful and a little anxious. The Lord is now taking our hand and leading us out for our Adam to recognize us. It's time for the sons of God to wake up and recognize his Eve. (*Genesis 2:20-22*) *But for Adam no suitable helper was found. 21 So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep, and while he slept, He took one of the man's ribs and closed up the area with flesh. 22 And from the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man, He made a woman and brought her to him...*

With the oppression starting to lift, it is a time of refreshment. It's time to step into the positions the Lord has called us to and run with it. The Lord is doing something new. (Isaiah 41:18) I will make rivers flow on barren heights, and springs within the valleys. I will turn the desert into pools of water, and the parched ground into springs.

(Matthew 17:1-9 NKJV) Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves; 2 and He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light. 3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. 4 Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." 5 While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" 6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid. 7 But Jesus came and touched them and said, "Arise, and do not be afraid." 8 When they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only. 9 Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, "Tell the vision to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead."

(Mark 10:29-31 NIV) "Truly I tell you," Jesus replied, "no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel³⁰ will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age: homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields—along with persecutions—and in the age to come eternal life.³¹ But many who are first will be last, and the last first."

(Luke 10:1-12 NIV) After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.² He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.³ Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves.⁴ Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road.⁵ "When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.'⁶ If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you.⁷ Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house.⁸ "When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to you.⁹ Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'¹⁰ But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say,¹¹ 'Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near.'¹² I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town."
