

Time is Short. Draw Close. Reach the Lost.

“Time is short before [judgment](#) and [war](#) comes to America”, says the Lord. “It will be a time of [great distress](#) such as never been, nor will be again. So it important for My children to do three things:

- 1) Draw close to Me and spend time with Me in your secret place, in prayer and in My Word. In the chaotic times to come, it will be critical for you to know My still, small voice, so you can hear Me as I guide and protect you through the chaos. If you do not spend time with Me, you will have nothing special – nothing supernatural – to share with others in their time of need.

“Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things which you do not know.” *Jeremiah 3:3*

- 2) Commune and with other believers in worship and prayer, so that you may minister to them and they can minister to you. A primary way for this to happen is through a local church. But it must be a Bible-believing church that holds up My Son Jesus Christ as Savior above all else. (This is described here: [25 Signs of a Healthy Church](#).)

“And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.” *Hebrews 10:24-25*

- 3) Reach out to the lost. Many, many people don’t know Me. They may know about Me, but they don’t know Me and My still, small voice that gives guidance and peace. They will be lost as cataclysmic events unfold and their lives are shaken to the core. So reach out to them with My truth and love, for life is short, eternity is a very long time, and you are not guaranteed tomorrow.”

“Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” *Matthew 28:18-20*
